CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR THE LEAD EA NETWORK

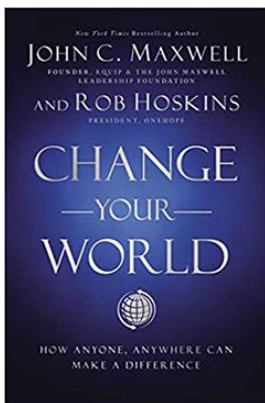
