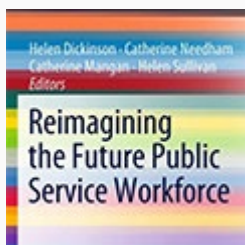

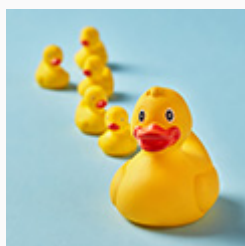
THE ESSENCE OF PUBLIC SERVICE
