AUDIENCE DEMOGRAPHICS



IPAA asked attendees a series of questions using Poll Everywhere.

There were 433 people registered to attend, as follows:

- 327 from the Australian Public Service (75%)
- 52 from the Private Sector (12%)
- 28 from Academia and NFP (6%)
- 26 from the ACT Government and other jurisdictions (6%)

From the 327 Australian Public Service attendees, the breakdown was:


- 41% SES officers

In terms of your contribution to ensuring the APS is 'fit for the future', how do you feel?










