



ANNUAL REPORT AWARDS BECOME AN ASSESSOR

Each year, IPAA ACT call for volunteer assessors to participate in the Annual Report Awards. Being an assessor is a challenging and rewarding experience that will enhance the skills of participants by exposing them to other agencies or bodies within the Commonwealth and ACT Government. There are no formal qualifications or experience required of assessors.

ASSESSOR TIMEFRAME AND WORKLOAD

The commitment required can vary, however based on past experience, approximately 4-6 days is required from early February to the end of March. It is preferred if these hours are negotiated release-time for the assessor in working hours, though they may be in the assessor's own time if work commitments do not permit release.

Assessors individually assess online versions of one or two annual reports against Award criteria. Then with a paired assessor they develop an agreed assessment for each annual report assigned. Where there is disagreed assessment, an independent assessor reads and reviews the assessments.
